

JOB ANNOUNCEMENT

Position: Nurse Practitioner

Reports to: Chief Medical Officer

Salary Range: Staring salary based on experience, qualification, and budget.
(100% time – 40 hours per week)

Position Purpose:

Under the direction of the Chief Medical Officer, and in compliance with the agency's Standardized Procedures, the Nurse Practitioner is responsible for direct client care.

Principal Responsibilities:

1. Elicit and/or review client histories in accord with standards.
2. Provide direct client services by physical examination, identifying findings/diagnosis, and instituting management/treatment plan.
3. Ensures informed consent of clients for physical assessment, and any treatment.
4. Provides information and education related to client care and treatment, as indicated.
5. Orders and reviews diagnostic tests as indicated by client histories and/or assessments.
6. Provides evaluation and follow-up for abnormal laboratory results.
7. Seeks consultation and/or plans proper referral, as indicated.
8. Maintains current knowledge by participation in training sessions, symposiums, didactic courses, etc.
9. Identifies problems areas in clinic flows, training needs, and lack of cooperation and communicates them to the Supervising Nurse Practitioner.
10. Provide community health workers and nursing attendants with education and training, as indicated.
11. Performs quarterly review of client referrals and laboratory follow-up abnormal physical findings and lab values.
12. Maintains compliance with standards stated in California Nurse Practice Act, and other pertinent regulatory agencies.
13. Performs other duties as assigned.

Requirements:

1. Two years experience in Quality Assurance activities.
2. Current California RN License.
3. Current California Nurse Practitioner Furnishing License
4. Current CPR Certification.
5. Ability to communicate effectively orally and in writing.
6. Bilingual (English/Spanish) a plus.
7. Ability to travel from site to site as needed.
8. Experience in working with clients and staff from diverse socio-economic, ethnic, and cultural background.
