Women's Residential Program, Mini House, serves women age 18 and over, who have a substance use problem. Mini House specializes in services for pregnant and parenting women. The length of stay is determined by medical necessity.

RECOVERY BRIDGE HOUSING

Recovery Bridge Housing is an abstinence-based, peer supported housing where women and their children can reside for 180 days. The residents must be enrolled in Outpatient Treatment concurrently.

Program Services:

- Safe and Sober Housing at two locations in South Los Angeles
- Communal cooking and sharing meals together
- Daily Morning Meditation and Community Meetings.
- Building community through, BBQs, celebrating holidays, birthdays and cultural events
- Establish employment and enrolling in school when clinically indicated by Outpatient Provider
- Child visits held on site
- Save money towards permanent housing
- Become a Peer Advocate
- Daily chores and weekly double scrub
- Supervised by RBH House Manager

MEDICATION ASSISTED TREATMENT

Wesley Health Center offers Medication Assisted Treatment to patients who want to reduce their use of opioids and/or alcohol. MAT is the use of FDA approved medications to treating substance use disorder. MAT in combination with individual counseling, outpatient or residential treatment provides a comprehensive approach to treatment substance abuse.
